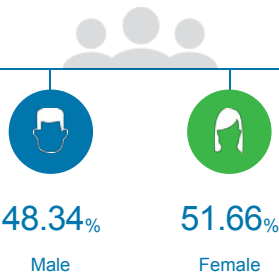

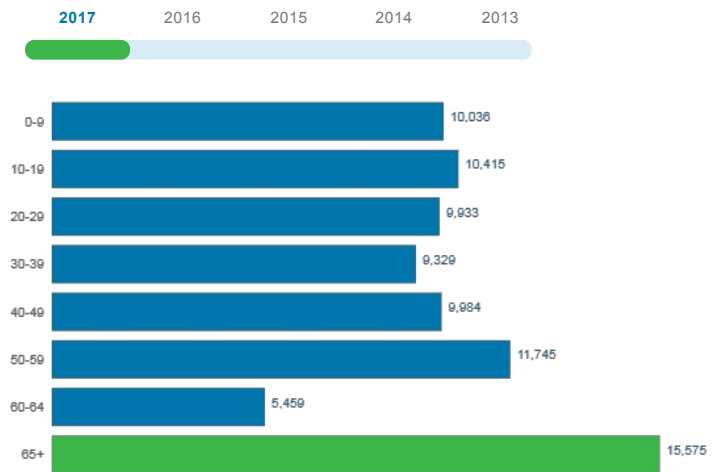
The total population of Howard County is 82,289. The median age is 40.59

Age Distribution



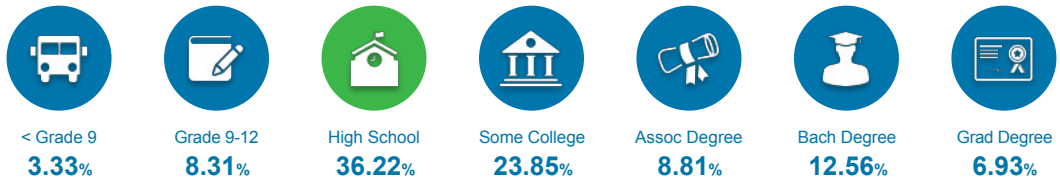

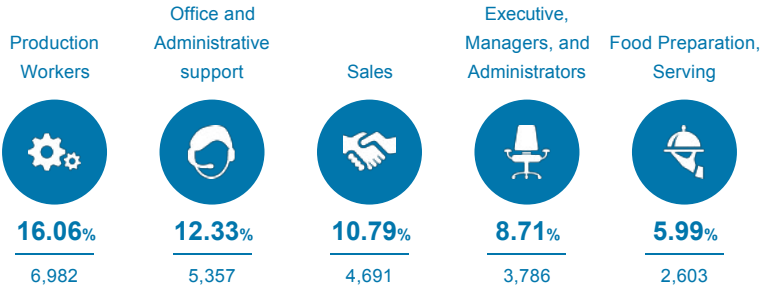

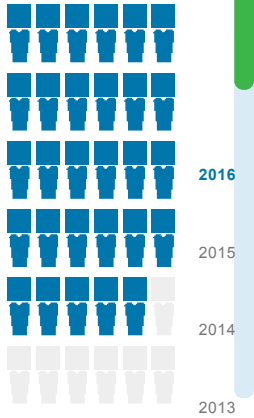

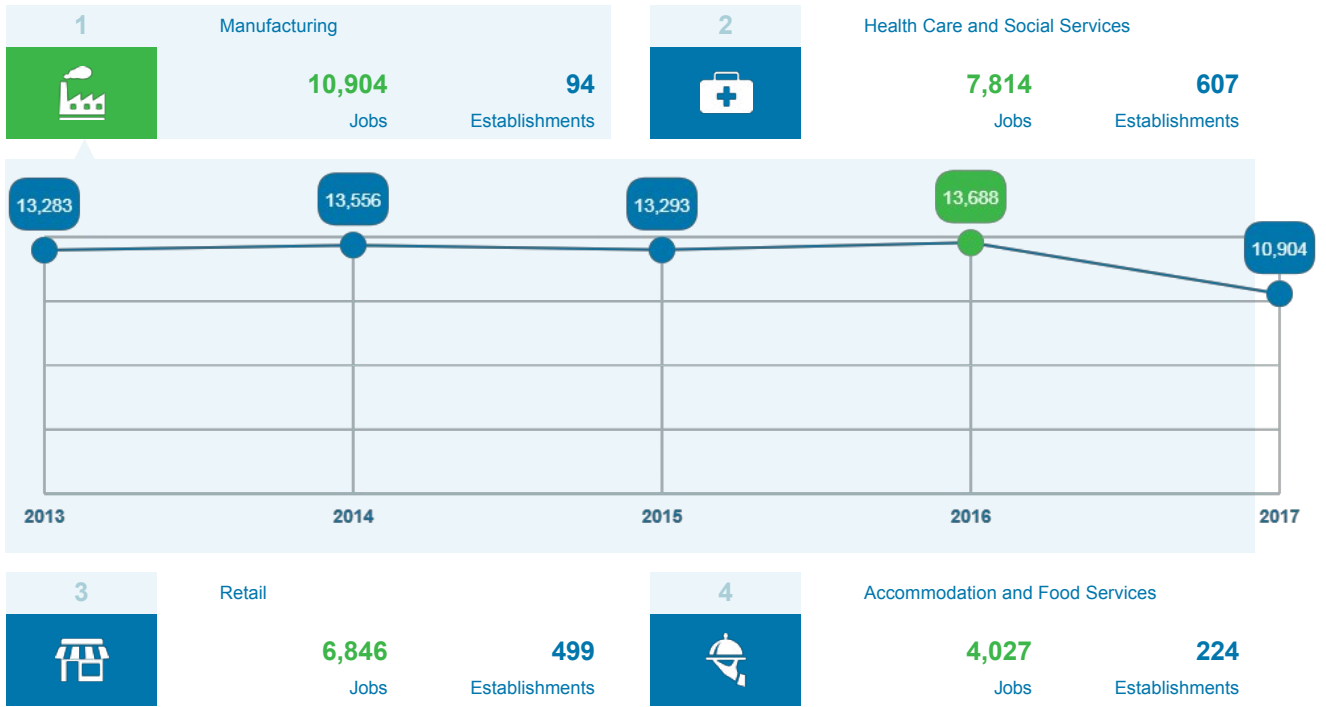

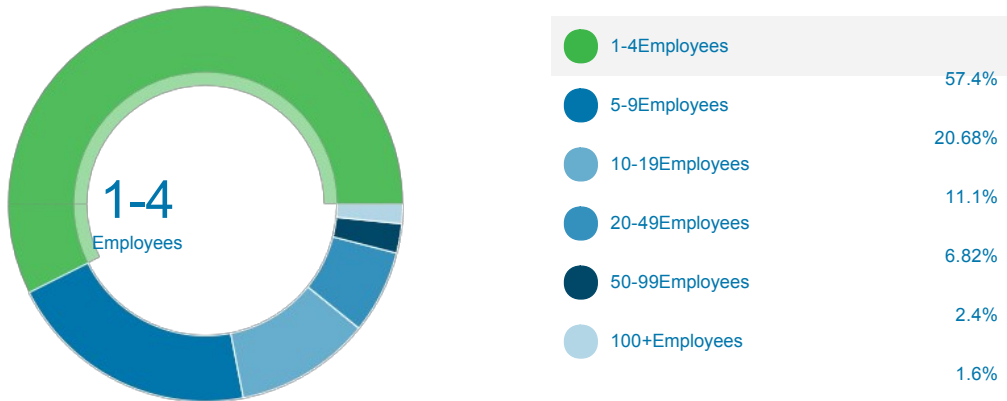

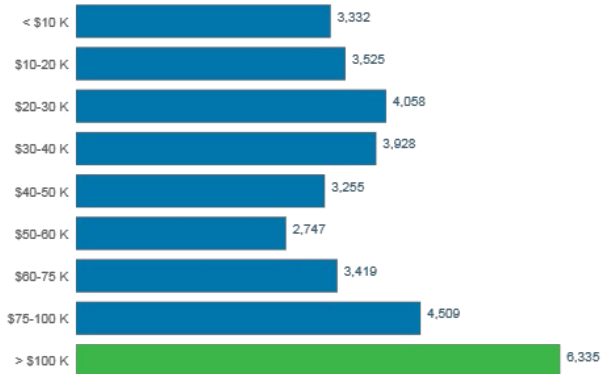

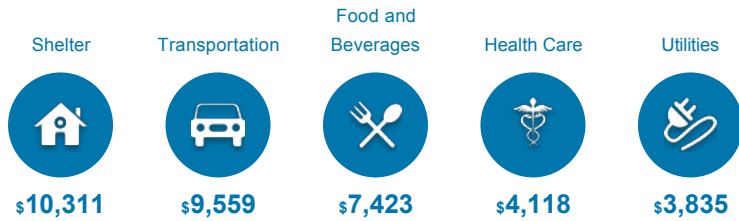

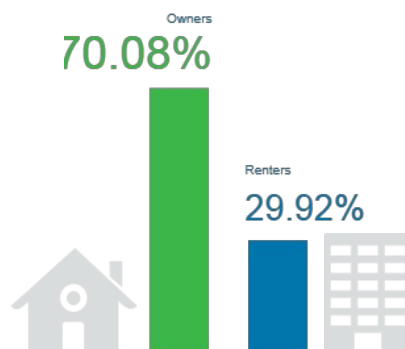
